Lost Words is a set of three abstract images that play with ideas of calligraphy. Held within deeply embossed grids, fragments of geometric shape, fold and intertwine, appearing like notional letters from a larger text.

Julia Farrer is a respected painter and printmaker whose works are held in many major museums throughout the world. She has shown in over 40 group exhibitions internationally including the Serpentine Gallery, London; the Hayward Annual, London; the New York Centre for Book Art; and Museum Pflazgallerie, Kaiserlautern. Her solo exhibitions include Air Gallery, London; Curwen Gallery, London; Francis Graham Dixon Gallery, London. She has been represented by the Eagle Gallery since 2000.

Farrer's work is held in collections including Arts Council England; Ashmolean, Oxford; Bibliotheque Nationale, Paris; British Museum; Fidelity PLC, London; Metropolitan Museum of Art, NY; TATE London; Victoria and Albert Museum, and Yale Center for British Art, USA.
