Stephen Chambers' prints comes from a series of works he has made over the last three years that explore the American Midwest as a metaphor for encounters, journeys and unchartered space. Their imagery relates to a monumental print work *The Big Country*, which was exhibited at the Royal Academy of Arts in 2012 and the Pera Museum, Istanbul in 2014. Journey Without Maps were printed with Kip Gresham at The Print Studio, Cambridge.

Chambers trained at St Martin's School of Art and Chelsea College of Art, London. He was awarded a British School at Rome Scholarship in 1983 and was elected to the Royal Academy in 2005. He has exhibited in the UK and internationally since the late 1980's, and was artist in residence at Kettle's Yard Cambridge (1988 - 89). His work is held in many major collections including Arts Council England; Clifford Chance, London; Fidelity Plc, London; Metropolitan Museum, New York, and the Victoria and Albert Museum, London.
